Pattern instructions for both Knitted & Crochet Baptism Prayer Shawls

A Prayer of Blessing

God bless you

on your baptism day

With love and prayers being sent your way

May His light

always shine upon your face

Bestowing love, goodness,

care and grace

It is recommended to use cheap acrylic wool that can be washed and tumble dried:

Knitted Baptism Prayer Shawl

DK wool 300 grams any colour [or mixed colours]. Number 8 needles.

Corner to Corner.

Cast on 2 stitches.

Knit 1 increase in second stitch knit to the end.

Continue increasing on every row until side measures 34 inches.

Knit 1 knit 2 together in the second stitch then knit to the end.

Continue in this way till all the stitches are off.

No border necessary.

Crochet Baptism Prayer Shawl

300grams DK wool [or mixed colours] Number 4 hook.

80 chains for four foot blanket.

Work 80 trebles along the row.

Work 70 rows to make 3 feet.

Finish off with 2 double crochet rows in any colour.
