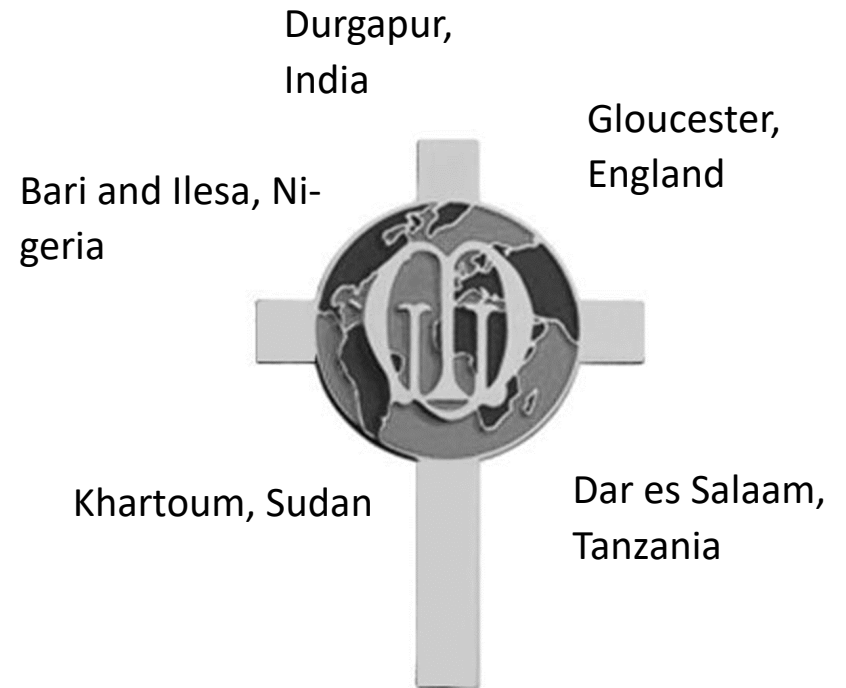




Wave of Prayer—Hymns
